#### **Science Activity Projects**

As I mentioned to you during Open House, I would get back to you concerning Science Fair. The fifth grade will not be participating in an organized Science Fair. In lieu of the Science Fair; students in both fifth grade classes will still be responsible to perform a Science Project. These projects will come from their Science Activity Manual. Students will be responsible for performing the project in the classroom and teaching it to their fellow students.

Students will need to have completed the project in advance, in its entirety, and have all materials to perform the experiment/project both at home and on the day that it is due. There will be one student performing weekly beginning Friday November 7. Students must choose their project and their date no later than **Thursday October 30, 2008**.
