# **Short Story Category:**

Spiritual or historical personality, theme, or idea
Fantasy, Mystery, Comedy, etc.
Originality plus believable plot
Good character development and conflict resolution
300-800 words

# **Essay/Narrative Category:**

- One main, pertinent/important theme developing a definition, concept, or idea
  - · Fresh, new, significant idea or thought
  - Controversial theme is allowed with moral and spiritual values evident
    - Introduction, Body of two to five points, Conclusion
      - Clear purpose/theme and logical organization 300-800 words

# Rhymed or Free Verse Poetry Category:

Evident, consistent theme relating to nature, spiritual concepts, or feelings/attitudes of people
Should evoke thoughts, imagination, emotion
Creative with poetic feel that reaches the heart
Vivid description, simile, metaphor

# Format for all entries:

Accurate word count (inaccurate or missing word count will result in disqualification) Student's name, grade school, city, and state at the top of the first page.

Typed and double-spaced

Font size 12 or larger with easily-read font style

No graphics, art, or presentation folders

No more than 2 spelling errors

Submit three copies of entry and email a copy of it to your teacher Moral/acceptable subject matter required for all entries.

One student may submit up to two entries (different categories).
