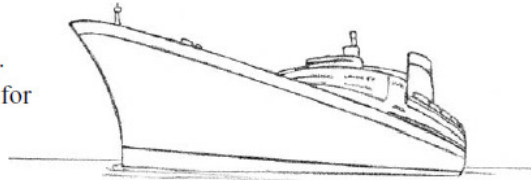

palm¹ | pām | *-noun, plural palms* The inside of a person's hand from the wrist to the fingers.

palm² | pām | *-noun, plural palms* One of many related types of evergreen tropical trees, shrubs, or vines with fan-like leaves.
